Details: Mariners are advised that, South Channel Beacon 14 (K2322-9) in position 38° 19.66' S 144° 51.63' E, is off station. The debris from the beacon have been recovered and no obstruction exists.

A temporary yellow buoy fitted with a yellow light flashing every 1.5 seconds (Fl.Y.1.5s) has been established in position 38° 19.67' S 144° 51.62' E to mark the entrance to the cut. Please see picture below. The buoy will remain in place until further notice.
