Notice NtM 345 (T) – 2020 and is here by cancelled.

Details: Mariners are advised that an Acoustic Doppler Current Profiler (**ADCP**) to measure water current velocities is established in position 38°02'20 S, 144°49.58'E (WGS84) in the vicinity of the 20-meter contour.

The water ADCP monitoring station is sitting on the sea floor at a maximum height of 50cm secured at the bottom with weights, which is marked by a virtual buoy ID -TB4.

The monitoring station will remain in place for approximately 30 days.

Mariners are advised to navigate with caution in the vicinity of the monitoring station.
