WATER QUALITY MONITORING STATION MOVED****Date:** 05 November 2021**Refers:** NtM 145 (P) / 2019 is hereby cancelled.**Details:** Mariners are advised that a water quality monitoring buoy that was deployed east of shipping fairway in position 38° 03.500'S, 144° 58.000'E, has now been moved to position **38° 03.506'S, 144° 52.217'E**

The water quality monitoring station will be marked by a yellow special buoy, fitted with a yellow light, flashing every 2.5 seconds (Fl.Y.2.5s). The monitoring station will remain in place for approximately 2 years with removal scheduled for November 2023.

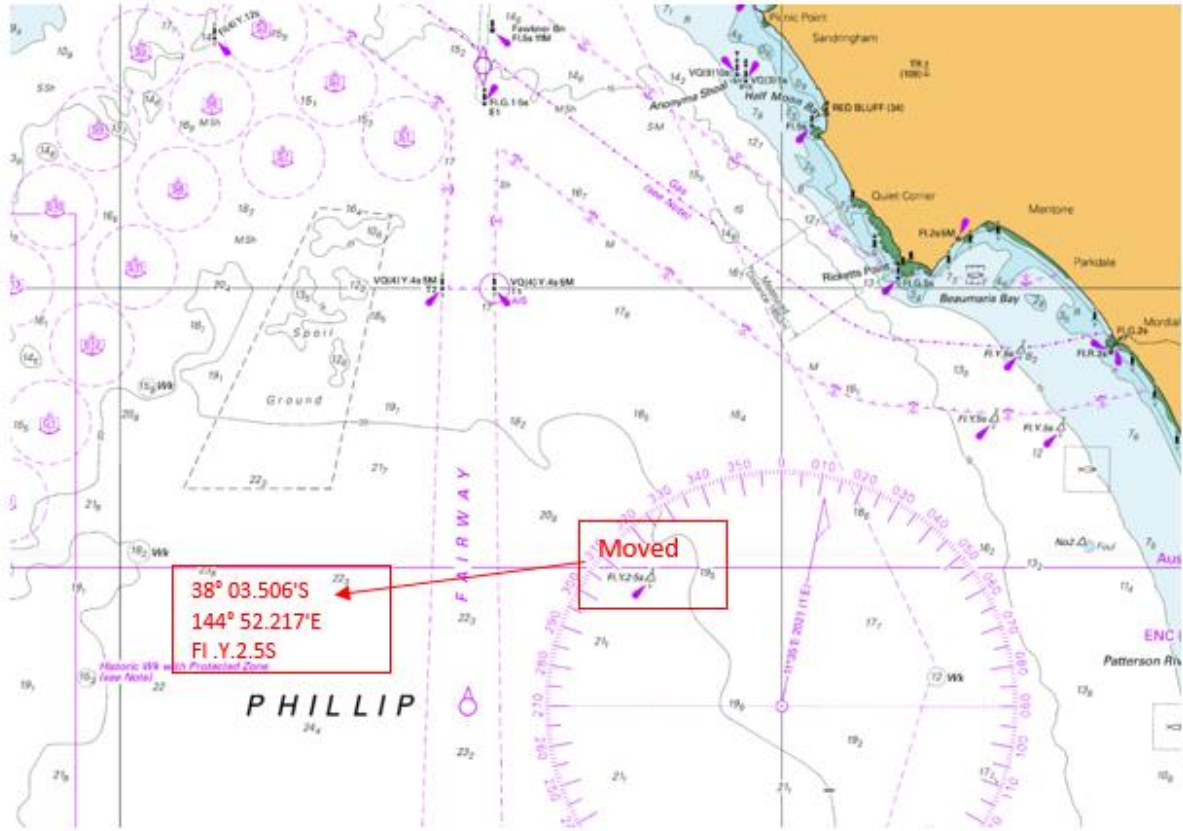
