PORT MELBOURNE CHANNEL BEACON 1 REPLACEMENT**Date:** 10 June 2022**Refers:** N/A**Details:** Mariners are advised that piling operations at Port Melbourne Channel Beacon 1 in position $37^{\circ}55.6'S144^{\circ}55.7E'$ will occur on or about 14 June 2022 during daylight hours, subject to weather.

The existing beacon top mark and green light flashing every 4 seconds (Fl.(2)G.4s) will be fitted on the new beacon 1.

The following vessels will be in attendance to support installation works:

1. MV LOBO – Crew transfer
2. Taree – Crane. Supply Barge
3. JUB II – Jack up Barge / Piling Barge
4. Taurus – Assist Tug

Mariners are advised that during piling operations, a 100m minimum wake temporary exclusion zone will be established in position $37^{\circ}55.6'S144^{\circ}55.7E'$. Authorised vessels of the operations are excepted.

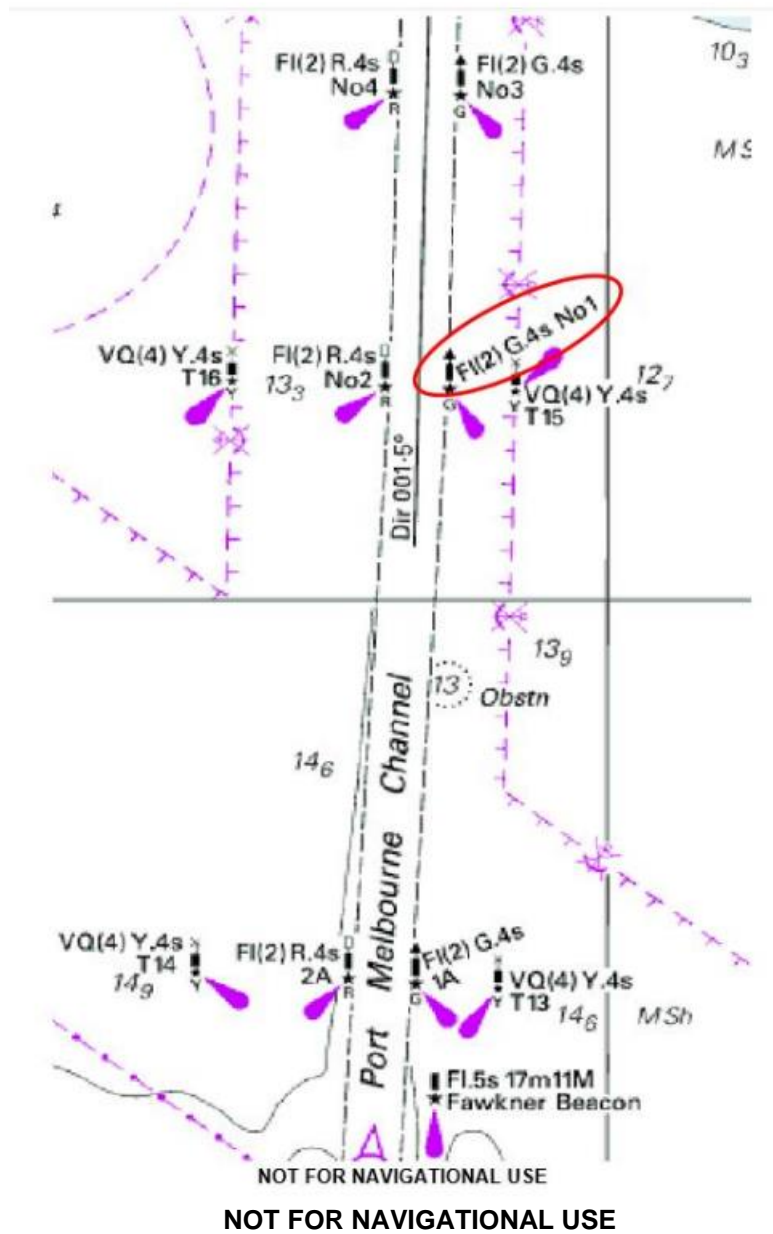
