### PORT OF MELBOURNE MARIBYRNONG RIVER WESTGATE TUNNEL PROJECT RIVER CLOSURES GOVERNMENT GAZETTED NOTICE AMENDED

**Date:** 8 November 2022

**Refers:** NtM 217 (T) / 2020  
NtM 132 (T) / 2022 and is here by cancelled.

**Details:** Mariners and port users are advised that construction works are taking place in Maribyrnong River extending halfway from the western and eastern bank, downstream of Shepherd Bridge to the extension of Youell Street, to 31 August 2023.

NtM 217 (T) / 2020 - Maribyrnong River - West Gate Tunnel Project Construction Works extended remains extant.

Mariners are advised that Maribyrnong River will be subject to full and partial closures between Shepherds Bridge and Youell Street during this period.

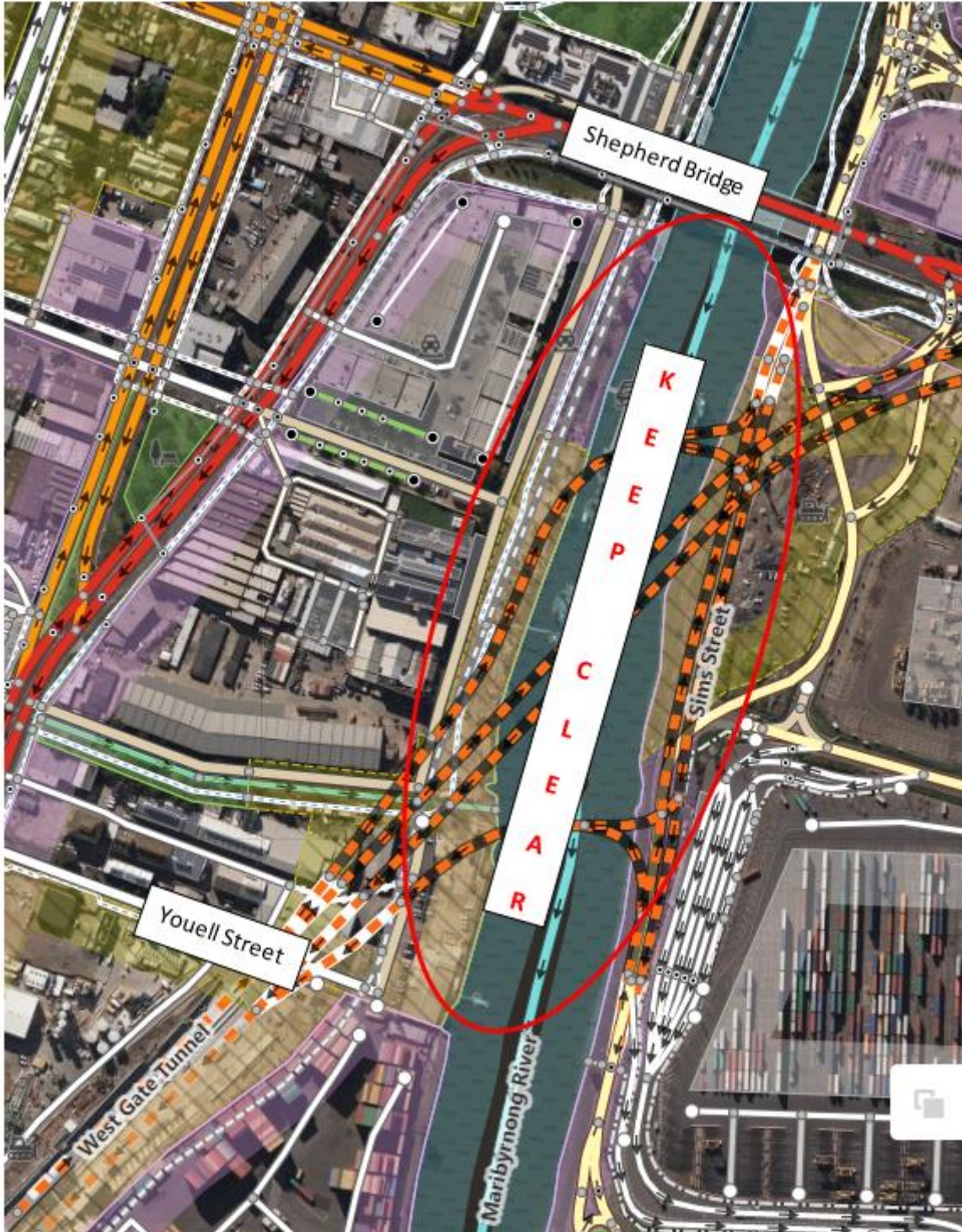

**NOTICE CONTROLLING NAVIGATION IN THE VICINITY OF WORKS**

I, Warwick Laing, Harbour Master – port of Melbourne, as authorised delegate of Ports Victoria, the port management body for the port waters of the Port of Melbourne, by this notice amend the notice published in the Government Gazette S 185 dated 8 April 2022 under the heading **Marine Safety Act 2010**, Section 211(1)(b), NOTICE CONTROLLING NAVIGATION IN THE VICINITY OF WORKS (Notice).

That Notice is amended such that it now is to be read as:

The navigation and movement of vessels is restricted and/or prohibited from waters of the Maribyrnong River as detailed below in Table 1, excluding vessels involved in the works and emergency response vessels.

<b>Open</b>  29 October to 8 November 2022	No closure.	Open to river traffic.

The amendment made by this notice comes into effect immediately. The Notice, as amended above, continues to remain in effect until 5.00 pm on 31 August 2023.
