SUBMERGED OBSTRUCTIONS**

Details: Mariners are advised that submerged obstructions (steel piles) exist in the immediate vicinity of the wharf face at Inner East Station Pier. The piles are approximately 1 metre south of the wharf edge and approximately 500mm above the seabed.

Temporary yellow buoys, marking the extent of the submerged obstructions, have been established in the following positions:

Buoy 1 - 37° 50.595' S, 144° 55.928' E

Buoy 2 - 37° 50.597' S, 144° 55.930' E

Mariners are advised to navigate with caution in the vicinity of the submerged obstructions.

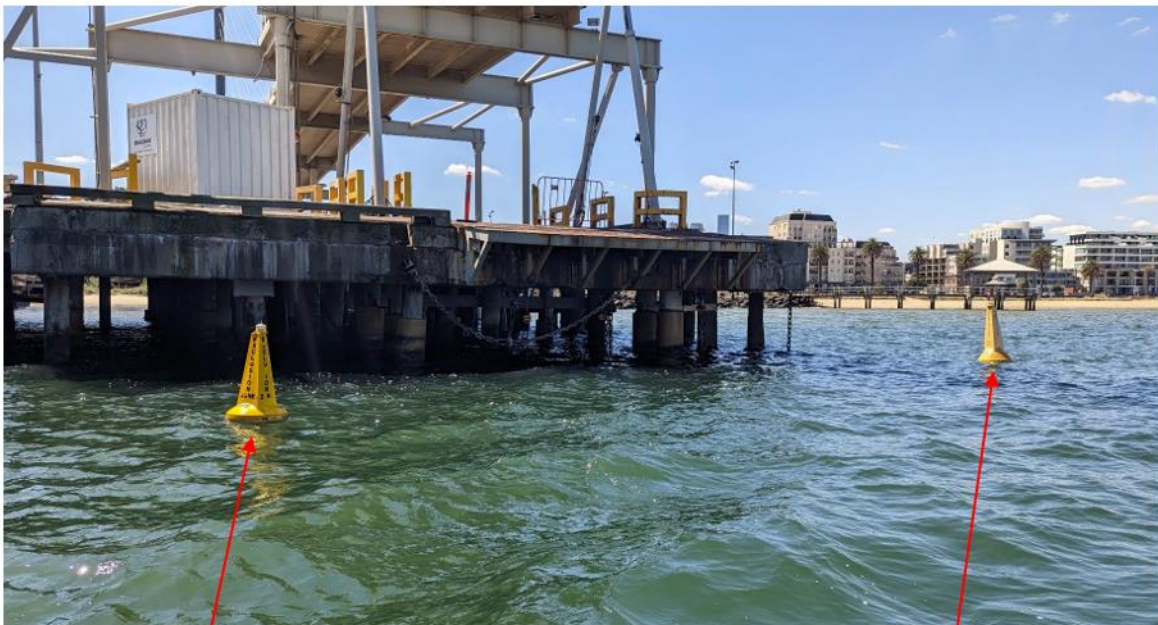
